BIOGRAPHY

Jessica McKean took her first singing lesson at two and a half. She entered her first competition the week of her third birthday and won it, in the age six and under category.

At ten she won Ireland's Junior Eurovision Song Contest on TG4, ahead of thousands of entrants and across weeks of live television, becoming the youngest winner in the contest's history. She went on to represent Ireland at the Palais Nikaia in Nice, singing to a full stadium and a broadcast audience of millions, in a song written for her in Irish.

She performs opera, musical theatre and classical crossover, and sings in English, Irish, Latin, French and Italian. She is working through her grades in piano and classical singing, and writes her own songs.
